

He served as Merton Professor of English Language and Literature at the University of Oxford from 1945 to 1959 and was a fellow of Merton College, Oxford, from 1925 to 1945 and 1959 to 1972.

Tolkien was born in Bloemfontein, South Africa, but his family moved back to England when he was three. He attended King Edward's School in Birmingham and later studied English language and literature at the University of Oxford.

After graduating from Oxford, Tolkien worked as a lexicographer on the Oxford English Dictionary. He also served in the British Army during the First World War, where he developed trench fever, which left him hospitalized for a long period of time.

After the war, Tolkien resumed his work on the Oxford English Dictionary and began writing poetry and short stories. He published The Hobbit in 1937 and The Lord of the Rings in 1954–1955. These works have since become some of the most popular and beloved fantasy novels of all time.

Tolkien died in Bournemouth, England, in 1973.


