Rose

- 3. Secure the point with a needle and thread.
- 4. Roll up the ribbon tightly, starting from the outside edge and working your way towards the point.
- 5. Once you reach the point, secure the roll with a needle and thread.
- 6. Unfold the lily, and then use your fingers to shape the petals.
- 7. Wrap floral tape around the stem of the lily.


