I'll never forget you, my love,

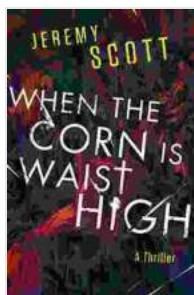
And I'll always cherish the time we had.

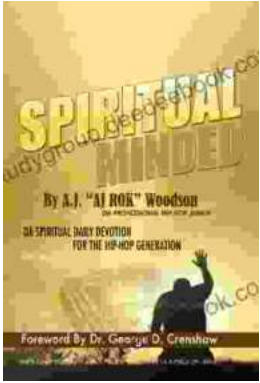
